## HMIS PARTNER AGENCIES

### ACCESS SUPPORT NETWORK (ASN)

The Access Support Network, or ASN, serves the San Luis Obispo County and Monterey County communities, assisting our neighbors, friends, and family living with HIV/AIDS. With the help of dedicated staff and volunteers, ASN works diligently to stabilize clients' health - financially, emotionally and physically, and all at no cost.

### CENTRAL COAST CENTER FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING (CCCIL)

CCCIL promotes the independence of people with disabilities by supporting their equal and full participation in life. CCCIL provides advocacy, education, and support to people with disabilities, their families, and the community.

### COMMUNITY HOMELESS SOLUTIONS

Community Homeless Solutions' mission is to be a leader in ending the cycle of homelessness or violence by providing safe housing, compassionate support, and opportunities for self-sufficiency through outreach, emergency shelter, transitional housing, and supportive services.

### COMMUNITY HUMAN SERVICES

Community Human Services alleviates human suffering and community problems in Monterey County caused by substance abuse and mental health issues by providing affordable prevention, counseling and recovery services for people suffering from substance abuse or mental health issues. Community Human Services also operates programs serving runaway and homeless youth.

### CSU MONTEREY BAY- CHINATOWN COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER

Chinatown Community Learning Center is a resource, not just for the homeless of the Chinatown area, but also for the entire community who needs free internet/computer access to keep in touch with families, perform job searches and other tasks where computers are necessary.

### Downtown Streets Team

Downtown Streets Team is ending homelessness by restoring the dignity and rebuilding the lives of unhoused men and women.

### FRANCISCAN WORKERS OF JUNIPERO SERRA

The Franciscan Workers, better known as Dorothy's Place or Streets to Homes, exists to serve our marginalized neighbors, to compassionately offer hospitality (basic needs), safety, case management toward better health and housing, housing navigation and a bridge to services they might feel are unavailable to them elsewhere.

## HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY

The Housing Authority of the County of Monterey (HACM) is a public agency that provides rental assistance and develops and manages affordable housing throughout Monterey County. It fulfills an important role in ensuring that affordable housing is available to the poorer residents of Monterey County.

## HOUSING RESOURCE CENTER

The Housing Resource Center of Monterey County is an independent non-profit housing resource agency. They provide resources ranging from emergency rental assistance to home ownership.

## INTERIM, INC.

Interim provides a continuum of residential treatment, supported affordable housing and supported employment and education services for adults with psychiatric disabilities residing in Monterey County. Interim's goal is to help adults with psychiatric disabilities to achieve satisfying, productive lives in the community and to attain the maximum level of independence possible.

## MIDPEN HOUSING CORPORATION

MidPen Housing provides safe, affordable housing of high quality to those in need and to establish stability and opportunities in the lives of our residents.

## SALVATION ARMY, MONTEREY PENINSULA CORPS

The Salvation Army has been serving the Monterey Peninsula since 1895. Through various programs they provide services to the homeless, low-income families, and youth of all ages and run a holiday assistance program each Thanksgiving and Christmas.

## SUN STREET CENTERS

Sun Street Centers is a premier provider of substance abuse education and recovery services in Monterey County. In addition to its educational and recovery services, it also operates a men's residential recovery center, transitional living programs drop resource centers located throughout the County.

## VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER
